*WHEREAS, pollination is vital to the health and resilience of our national forests and grasslands, which provide forage, wildlife habitat, clean water, timber, mineral resources, recreation, and economic opportunities for communities across our state; and*

*WHEREAS, pollinator species deliver significant environmental benefits that sustain healthy, diverse ecosystems and support the long-term wellbeing of our natural landscapes; and*

*WHEREAS, the State of New Mexico has long managed wildlife habitats, forests, and grasslands with a commitment to conservation, stewardship, and ecological health; and*

*WHEREAS, the State of New Mexico provides producers with conservation assistance that promotes responsible land stewardship, including the protection and enhancement of pollinators and their habitats on working lands and wildlands.*

*NOW THEREFORE, I, Michelle Lujan Grisham, Governor of the State of New Mexico, do hereby proclaim June 22<sup>nd</sup> through 28<sup>th</sup>, 2026, as:*

## **"New Mexico Pollinator Week"**


