WHEREAS, pollinator species such as birds and insects are essential

partners of farmers and ranchers in producing much of

our food supply; and

WHEREAS, pollination plays a vital role in the health of our national

forests and grasslands, which provide forage, wildlife, timber, water, mineral resources and enhanced economic development

for communities; and

WHEREAS, pollinator species provide significant environmental benefits

that are necessary for maintaining healthy, biodiverse

ecosystems; and

WHEREAS, Louisiana has managed wildlife habitats and public lands such

as forests and grasslands for decades; and

WHEREAS, our state provides producers with conservation assistance to

promote wise conservation stewardship, including the

protection and maintenance of pollinators and their habitats on

working lands and wildlands.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, John Bel Edwards, Governor of the State of Louisiana, do

hereby proclaim June 21 - 27, 2021 as

POLLINATOR WEEK

in the State of Louisiana.
