WHEREAS, The State of Maryland has managed wildlife habitats and public lands such as Maryland's forests and grasslands for decades; and

WHEREAS, The State of Maryland provides producers with conservation assistance to promote wise conservation stewardship, including the protection and maintenance of pollinators and their habitats on working lands and wildlands.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LAWRENCE J. HOGAN, JR., GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND, do hereby proclaim JUNE 21 - 27, 2021, as MARYLAND POLLINATOR WEEK in Maryland and do commend this observance to all of our citizens.
