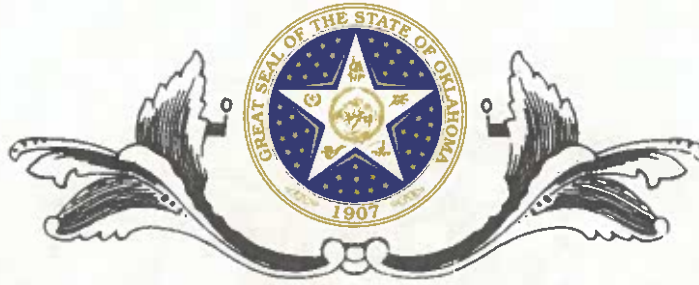

Proclamation

Whereas, pollinator species, including birds, bees, butterflies, and other insects, play a vital role in supporting Oklahoma's agricultural production and food supply; and

Whereas, pollination contributes to the health of Oklahoma's forests, grasslands, and natural resources, which support wildlife, water quality, recreation, and economic activity across our state; and

Whereas, pollinators provide essential environmental benefits that help maintain healthy and diverse ecosystems throughout Oklahoma; and

Whereas, Oklahoma has a long history of managing wildlife habitats, public lands, and working lands to support conservation and responsible stewardship; and

Whereas, farmers, ranchers, and conservation partners across Oklahoma work to protect pollinator habitats through sustainable practices and conservation efforts; and

Whereas, recognizing Pollinator Week provides an opportunity to raise awareness about the importance of pollinators and encourage continued conservation efforts across the State of Oklahoma;

Now Therefore, I, Governor J. Kevin Stitt, do hereby proclaim
June 22nd - 28th, 2026, as

"Oklahoma Pollinator Week"
