Why Pollinators?

Our Strategy



Pollinators are the bees, butterflies, birds, and other animals that help agriculture produce an estimated 1 out of every



3 bites of food we eat. They are critical to the health of our planet.

Pollinators are in dire trouble, largely due to loss of habitat. The result?
Unstable global food supply,
unhealthy ecosystems, and dramatic loss of biodiversity.



- 85% of all flowering plants on the earth need help from pollinators to reproduce.
- Pollinators and their habitat help reverse the impacts of climate change.
- Pollinators add **\$217 billion dollars** annually to the global economy.
- We lose 175 acres of farmland and habitat every hour, or 1.5 million acres per year, roughly the size of Delaware.

Build Habitat

Our Bee Friendly Farming program has certified 130,000 acres of habitat in one year alone. This has resulted in more than 60,000 acres of pollinator habitat in critical agricultural landscapes.



Conduct Break-Through Research

Pollinator Partnership conducts research and has also distributed more than \$1 million in grants to research institutions across North America for honey bee health. The findings from this research have informed wide-ranging policy, beekeeping and farming operations, and conservation efforts.

Empower Everyone to Act

Our Monarch Wings Across America program has trained more than 1,000 volunteers in native seed collection and plant identification, resulting in 100,000 acres of enhanced habitat for monarch butterflies and other pollinators.



Create Lasting Change Through Collaboration

Pollinator Partnership founded and leads the North American Pollinator Protection Campaign (NAPPC). NAPPC is a collaborative of more than 170 of the most influential government agencies, corporations, agricultural groups, and academic institutions that creates tools, policy, curriculum, and guidance to protect pollinators across North America.
