Protecting Pollinators, People, and the Planet



Why Pollinators?

Pollinators are the bees, butterflies, birds, and other animals that help agriculture produce an estimated **1 out of every 3 bites of food** we eat. They are critical to the health of our planet.



Pollinators are in dire trouble, largely due to loss of habitat. The result? Unstable global food supply, unhealthy ecosystems, and dramatic loss of biodiversity.



- **85%** of all flowering plants on the earth need help from pollinators to reproduce.
- Pollinators and their habitat help **reverse** the impacts of climate change.
- Pollinators add **\$217 billion dollars** annually to the global economy.
- We lose **175 acres** of farmland and habitat every hour, or 1.5 million acres per year, roughly the size of Delaware.

Our Strategy

Build Habitat

Our Bee Friendly Farming program has enrolled more than 400,000 acres of farmland. This has resulted in more than 170,000 acres of pollinator habitat in critical agricultural landscapes.



Conduct Break-Through Research

Pollinator Partnership conducts research and has also distributed more than \$1 million in grants to research institutions across North America for honey bee health, imperiled *Bombus* conservation, and Lepidoptera conservation. The findings from this research have informed wide-ranging policy and best management practices for beekeeping, farming operations, and conservation efforts.

Empower Everyone to Act

Our Project Wingspan programs have trained more than 1,000 volunteers in native seed collection and plant identification, resulting in 100,000 acres of enhanced habitat for monarch butterflies and other pollinators.



Create Lasting Change Through Collaboration

Pollinator Partnership founded and leads the North American Pollinator Protection Campaign (NAPPC). NAPPC is a collaborative of more than 170 of the most influential government agencies, corporations, agricultural groups, and academic institutions that creates tools, policy, curriculum, and guidance to protect pollinators across North America.
